## VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMITS « RESEARCHER STATUS » (except for Algerians nationals <sup>(\*)</sup>)

If you are a national of a Member State of the European Union (EU), the European Economic Area (EEA), Andorra or Switzerland, you do not need a visa in France.

To enter in France and carry out scientific research, it is generally necessary to obtain a visa. The type of visa required will depend

on:

1) Your nationality

2) The length of your stay (less than 3 months, between 3

and 12 months, more than 12 months) 3) The reason for your stay (studies, research, teaching,

researcher, family of a researcher) 4) How your stay will be financed (employment contract in France, travel grant)

## STATUS AND SPECIFIC VISAS

- If you are a student enrolled in a PhD programme in France.

If you are receiving funding from a foreign government grant or an international joint programme: you retain 'Student' status OR receive the 'Researcher' status for your visa The host institution will assess which option is the best for you.

- If you are a researcher and you have an employment contract in France OR you are a visiting researcher but remain employed by your home institution OR you are a visiting researcher with a grant (minimal amont requested).

Your host institution will issue you with an <u>agreement to host a foreign</u> researcher or teacher ('Convention d'accueil d'un chercheur ou d'un enseignant étranger'). This document must be presented when applying for a Researcher-Talent passport visa ('Passeport-Talent Chercheur') and be signed by French consular authorities in your place of residence. UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

- If you have a **3-month VCS short stay visa** (less than 3 months), you do not have to take any further action.

- If you hold a **Researcher-Talent Passport long stay visa séjour (VLS)** ('Visa long séjour (VLS) mention "Passport-Talent chercheur'), you must <u>apply online for a residence permit</u> within two months of your arrival on the ANEF website.

- If you hold a Long stay visa serving as a residence permit under the 'Researcher' status (VLS-TS) ('Visa long séjour valant titre de séjour (VLS-TS) mention "Chercheur'), within three months of your arrival in France, you must validate your visa on the ANEF website.

If you wish to remain in France after your residence permit runs out, you must apply for a renewal between the 120th and 60th day before the expiry of the title, i.e. between the 4th and 2nd month.

(article R431-5 1° du CESEDA) *n.b. :* 

\* A request made between the 2nd month before expiry and the 6th month after expiry is now subject to the late fee of €180.

\* Any request made more than 6 months after the expiry of the residence permit will be rejected (art R 431-8 CESEDA).

- You have a **Student' residence** permit and wish to change your status (employment contract in France with hosting agreement), you can apply for an initial 'Passeport-Talent Chercheur' residence permit on the ANEF website.

- You have a Researcher-Talent Passport or a Long stay visa serving as a residence permit under the 'Researcher' status (VLS-TS) and your employment contract or stay (visiting researcher) is extended: a new hosting agreement for foreign researcher or teacher ('Convention d'accueil d'un chercheur ou d'un enseignant étranger') will have to be issued by your host institution. You can then apply to renew your 'Passeport-Talent Chercheur' residence permit on the ANEF website.

(\*) Algerian researchers (or PhD students) cannot use the ANEF tele-procedure to apply for/renew their residence permit. They will continue to submit their request by post OR by booking an appointment with the prefectural services according to their residence area.
